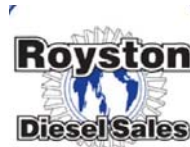

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (“rules”).
- 1.2 The prescriptions of Yachting Australia (YA) will apply.
- 1.3 The rules of the Red Witch Association will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Red Witch Class whose skipper and crew are members of a yacht club affiliated with YWA and financial members of the Red Witch Association.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it together with the required fee to the Secretary, Red Witch Association, 12 Welwyn Avenue Manning 6152.

3. FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Entry Fee \$100

Presentation BBQ \$25.00 per Adult, \$15.00 per child 12 years and under.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration from 0730 to 0800 Saturday 4 March.
- 4.2 Competitors Briefing will take place at 0800 on Saturday 4 March in “Archies Bar” located adjacent to the On Water Group Offices at South of Perth Yacht Club.
- 4.3 Six races are scheduled as follows:

Race 5 (Fixed Mark Course)	Sunday 4 March	0845
Race 6 (Fixed Mark Course)	Sunday 4 March	As soon as practical following race 3

- 4.4 No warning signal will be made after 1630 on either day.
- 4.5 Presentation BBQ will take place from 6.00pm onwards in “Archies Bar” at South of Perth Yacht.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be made available after 1700 on Thursday 1 March on the SoPYC website.

6. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on Melville Water East on the Swan River adjacent to South of Perth Yacht Club as shown in Attachment A.

7. THE COURSES

The courses will be a mixture of windward leeward and fixed mark courses as described in the sailing instructions.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 Scoring shall be in accordance with the Low Point Scoring system of Appendix A.
- 9.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 9.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When 5 to 6 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.4 For consistency results, handicaps will be calculated for all races. Performance will be assessed over the first three races and a starting handicap will then be calculated and applied from the first race for the purpose of determining consistency results. Yachts finishing in the first three places in the championship event will be excluded from the overall consistency results.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in both Championship and Consistency results. The results will be announced at South of Perth Yacht Club at the Presentation BBQ on Sunday 4th March at approximately 6.30pm.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or the equivalent.

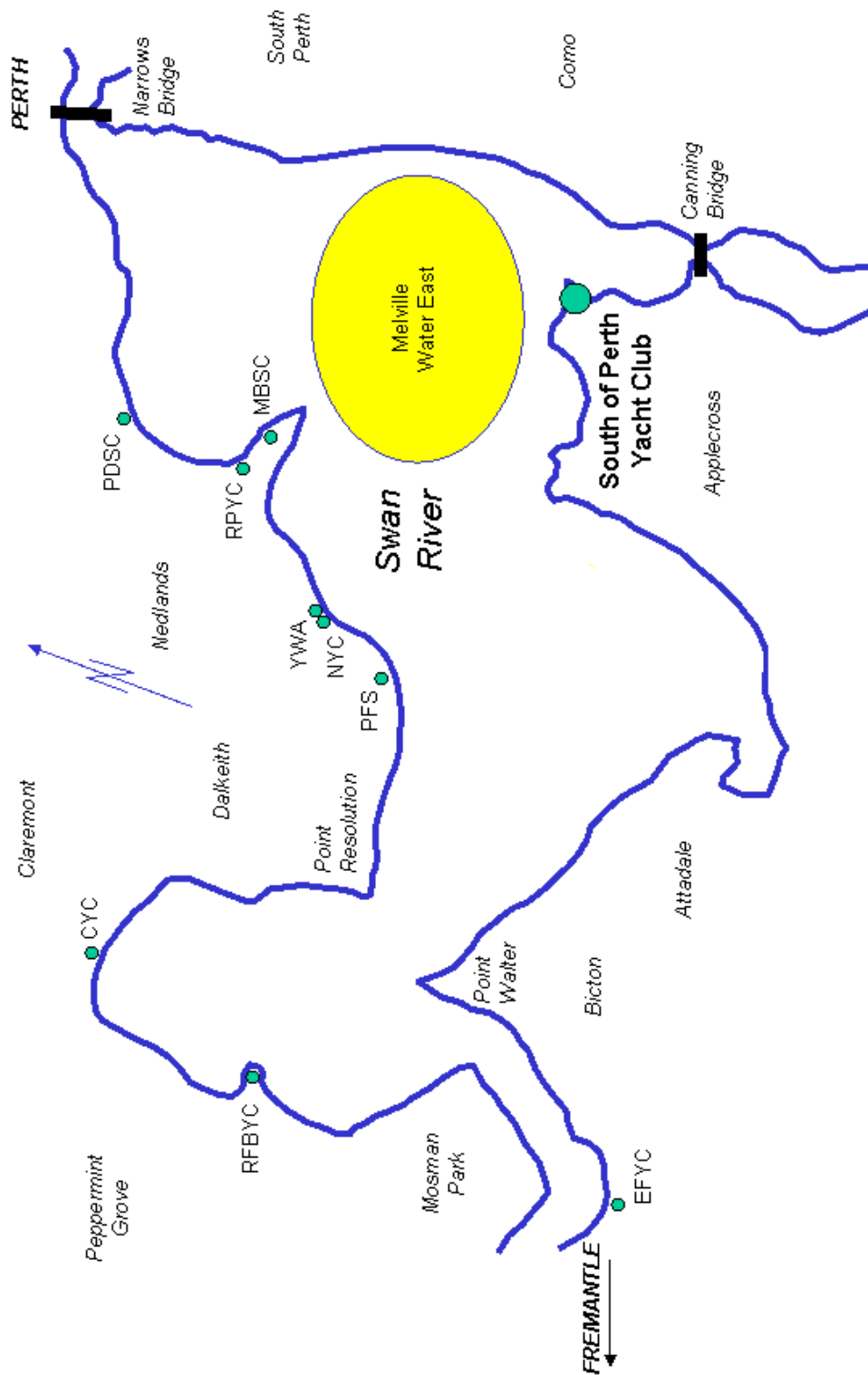
